BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

- Paul got on a ship to sail to Rome.
- The ship got caught in a strong storm.
- An angel told Paul that everyone on the ship would survive.
- Some sailors wanted to abandon the ship, but Paul told them not to.
- The ship ran into a sandbar and broke apart, but everyone made it to shore safely.
- Paul trusted God to rescue him.
