Organization Information: Christ's Body Ministry provides a day shelter and mobile outreach for those experiencing homeless in Denver. They provide pastoral care, food, clothing, showers, laundry, haircuts and other resources.

Project Details: Assist the mobile outreach team as they pack up the outreach van, go to homeless camps and serve a meal, offer clothing and prayer to individuals at the camps as well as clean-up trash around the site. The goal of this project is to meet people who are experiencing homelessness, hear their story and pray for them as well as meet some practical needs. *This project is for adults only (ages 18 and up).*
